

VICTORIAN CLUB PERMIT SCHEME PROPOSAL

9th December 2009

In 2010 the old club permit scheme will be phased out.

The scheme applies to cars over 30 years old and members of AOMC recognized clubs.

The new scheme will have the following:

45 DAY CLUB PERMIT.

- Vehicle can be used for up to 45 days in a 12 month period.
- You must place an entry in the supplied log book if you are moving the vehicle further than 50 metres from your house. The log book must be carried at all times.
- A day is from 00:01 hrs to 24:00 hrs (e.g. If you use your car on a Wednesday and arrive home early hours on a Thursday this equals 2 days car use)
- If after a few months you decide that 45 days use is not enough you can buy another 45 day permit to extend the use during the same 12 months. (This makes your permit similar to buying a 90 day permit)

Cost

- Permit \$18.70
- TAC Charge (not announced) but expected to be approx half of the yearly fee of \$75 plus admin costs.
- Log Book \$10.

90 DAY CLUB PERMIT

- Vehicle can be used for up to 90 days in a 12 month period.
- You must place an entry in the supplied log book if you are moving the vehicle further than 50 metres from your house.
- A day is from 00:01 hrs to 24:00 hrs (e.g. If you use your car on a Wednesday and arrive home early hours on a Thursday this equals 2 days car use)

Cost

- Permit \$37.40
- TAC Charge (not announced) but expected to be approx \$75
- Log Book \$10.

Note:

- This is our interpretation of the proposed scheme which may vary between now and when introduced.
- If a log book is "lost" there will be an extremely high cost for a replacement (to discourage people from fraudulent use of the program)
- A similar system is already operating in South Australia and has been accepted by all parties.
